- Measurement



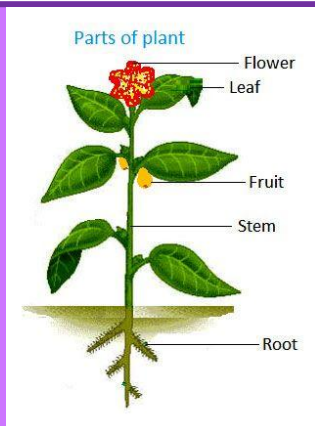
End of term project :
