World Book Day

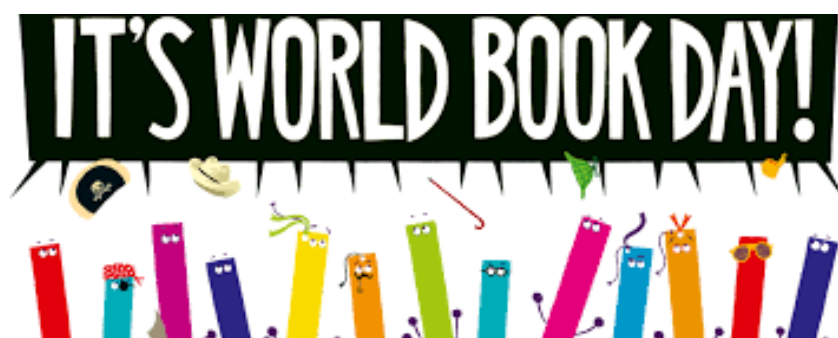
World Book day will be happening on Thursday 4th March. All children will receive their world book day token during the week beginning 8th March.

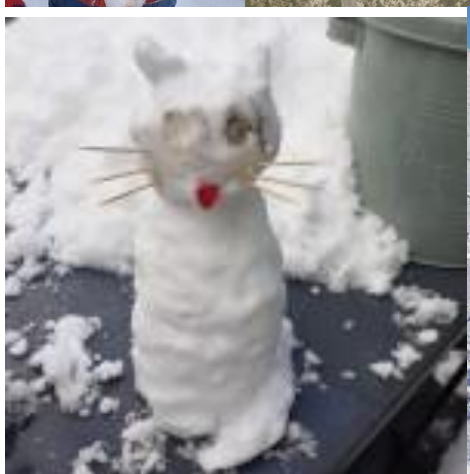
