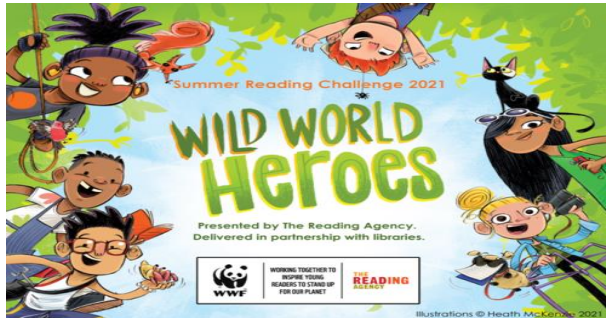


KITZ4KIDS Update
